Departmental Reports

He has been looking into water system issues and addressing new water meter problems, food truck ordinance, Charter review, burning ordinance, and will look into a new policy about buying local.

Mill Street road repair.

Discuss formation of a Charter/ Ordinance Review Commission.






Mayor Burris called the Special Meeting to order at 1:45 p.m.


